C. Melvin Anderson was born October 13, 1909 in Blakesburg, Iowa the son of Alfred and Selma Anderson. He was educated in Ottumwa, Iowa where he graduated from the Ottumwa High School. He then attended and graduated from the AIB Business School and was employed by Metropolitan Life as an insurance salesman. On September 2, 1939 he was united in marriage to Margaret L. Wood. Following their marriage they made

their home in Newton until he entered the United States Army where he actively served his country during World War II. Following his honorable discharge he returned to work for Metropolitan Life in Newton for a short time. C Melvin Anderson received a promotion and then moved to Marshalltown in 1949 where he worked as an agent manager until his retirement in 1975. C. Melvin Anderson was a member of the Central Christian Church, the Marshalltown Rotary, the Marshall Masonic Lodge #108, Seignet Chapter # 38, King Solomon Counsel # 20, St. Aldemar Commandry, Madon Shrine Chapter #38 W.S.J., the Central Chapter # 67 of the O.E.S. and the American Legion Frank-Lewis-Glick Post # 839. He is survived by his wife Margaret of Marshalltown, and his sister Marian Anderson of Ottumwa. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother Lennart Anderson.
