John Carr Andrew, 92, formerly of Colo, died on Monday, October 27, 2008 at his daughter's

home in Bondurant. Funeral services will be held 2:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 30 at the Colo United Methodist Church with Pastor Lewis Flanigan officiating. Burial will follow in the Colo Cemetery.
