W. W. Ballard of Cambridge died Saturday at Long Beach, Calif. He had been in the hospital since Dec. 17 with a heart ailment.

He was 84, born Oct. 7, 1871 in the White Oak community.

He was a school superintendent in Iowa for more than 45 years, serving in Cambridge, Collins Murray Story City Panorama, Rockford and Huxley.

Mr. Ballard was a member of the Christian church at Elkhart. Funeral will be there Friday at 2 p.m. with the Rev. Paul Frahm in charge. Burial will be in White Oak cemetery.

He was married to Minnie Thompson, Sept. 5, 1893. She died in 1937. He married Mrs. Alice Welch, May 10, 1940. She survives along with two son, Robert E., Lincoln, Nebr., and Virgil W., San Francisco, and two daughters, Mrs. Beulah White, of Des Moines and Mrs. Ferol Craven, Cambridge.
