**Edward Harold Ballentine**

**July 3, 1916, to Nov. 10, 2002**

**Edward "Ed" Harold Ballentine, 86, of Bettendorf and formerly of Nevada, died Sunday, Nov. 10, in Davenport from complications of a heart attack.**

**He was born July 3, 1916, in Leon, Ohio, to William David and Floy Del (Norman) Ballentine. He married F. Ruth Frazier on Nov. 21, 1941, in Andover, Ohio. He was a veteran, having served in the Army, and he worked as a sales manager for the Central Petroleum Company, retiring in 1981. He had lived in Andover, Ohio; Kokomo, Ind.; Nevada and moved to Bettendorf in 1995. He was a pilot and enjoyed flying his own plane.**

**Survivors include two sons, Edward "Ed" (and Patty) Ballentine, Jr., of Sterling, Va., and Blaine (and Tatiana) Ballentine of Bettendorf; four grandchildren; a brother, John Ballentine of Andover, Ohio; and a sister, Virginia Dustman of Ohio.**

**He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife on Feb. 28, 1994; four brothers, William David, Jr., Norman, Timothy and Fred; and three sisters, Mary Ellen, Kate Mossbarger and Julia Russell.**

**Graveside services were held Wednesday at Evergreen Memorial Garden Cemetery near Nevada. Bacon Funeral Home, Nevada, handled arrangements.**
