Eva Edna Beal, 98, of Zearing, formerly of Maxwell, died of pneumonia at Mary Greeley Medical Center, Ames.



She was born in Maxwell to John William and Minnie Etta (Belcher) Bloomfield. She was a lifetime resident of Story County and was employed as a school bus driver for Milford Township and as a cook at the Story Hotel in Nevada. She was a member of the Maxwell Christian Church.
