## CHARLES ELIJAH BISHOP

Charles Elijah Bishop, 72 of Maxwell, died Monday, Aug. 15, 1983 at the Story County Hospital in Nevada.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, Aug. 18 at the Maxwell Christian Church, with Rev. Eldon Ringle officiating. Burial will be at the Evergreen Memorial Gardens in rural Nevada.

Bishop was born in Christian County, Mo., on April 25, 1911 to Sarah Carolyn (Hayes) and E. Matthew Bishop. He married Adeline R. Wax on Feb. 6, 1949 in Marshalltown.

Bishop was an employee of the Maytag Co. in Newton from 1951 through 1979, when he retired. He had been a resident of Maxwell for the past 24 years.

He is survived by his wife, Adeline; two sons, Charles C. Bishop of Las Vegas, Nev., and Leonard Bishop of Ames; one daughter, Carolyn Bishop of Ames; three grandchildren; and two sisters, Eileen Hughes of Tulsa, Okla., and Pearl Pinsley of Kansas City, Mo.
