

George Blink, Former Local Resident, Dies

George Blink, for many years a farmer in the Rhodes neighborhood and a former resident of Marshalltown, passed away at 10:50 o'clock Friday forenoon at his home in Nevada. Death was due to apoplexy. Mr. Blink suffered a stroke a week or so ago and failed to rally.
