Mrs. Roy (Alice) Bogan, 86, of State Center, died Saturday, July 27, 2002 at the Southridge Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Marshalltown.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, July 31 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in State Center with Pastor Ron Darge officiating. Burial followed at Rose Hill Memorial Gardens.
