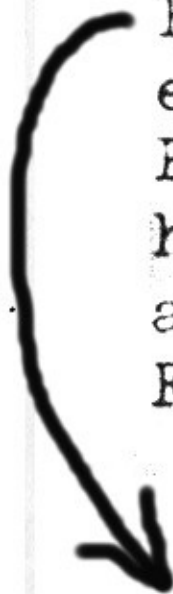
She was preceded in death by her husband, Charles, who died in 1962.
