Adolph Breer of Baxter, 81, died Sunday evening at Marshalltown Community Hospital East.

Breer was born Nov. 11, 1891, in Jackson County to William and Cecelia Wilsterman Breer. He was raised and educated in Marshall and Jasper Counties, farming all of his life in those areas. He retired 16 years ago and moved to Collins. He was a WWI veteran and member of the Bethany United Church of Christ in Baxter.

He married Kathrine Sinkler on July 17, 1918, in Baxter. She preceded him in death in 1930. Also preceding in death were his parents, two daughters in infancy and a brother.

Survivors include two sons, Robert Breer of Baxter and Lloyd Breer of Collins; one daughter, Mrs. Howard (Alice) Evans of Collins; eight grandchildren, five great grandchildren, two brothers, Levi of State Center and Herman of Nevada, and one sister, Mrs. Helen Schweinebart of Baxter.

Funeral services are set for Wednesday at 1:30 p.m. from the Bethany United Church of Christ in Baxter, with Rev. Harold Behle officiating. Burial will be at the Bethany Cemetery in Baxter. The Boyd-Nickell Funeral Home of Baxter is in charge of arrangements.
