### Obituary.

Florence Maud Brown, oldest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. D. W. Brown, was born in Collins township, Story County, July 18, 1892, and died in the same place Sept. 14, 1908, aged 16 years, 1 month and 26 days.

The funeral was held at Willow Creek Church Tuesday afternoon, Rev. C. E. Burton preaching a tender and comforting sermon. The choir sang at the funeral and the grave, and floral tributes were many and beautiful. The interment was at Collins Cemetery beside the graves of two of her brothers. A large assemblage of rel-

atives, neighbors and friends were present. The pallbearers were Crescy, Ethel and Ica Downing, Bertha and Bessie Brown and Ethel Elliott.

Deceased had been in delicate health for the past few years. Last October she was taken to New Mexico and later to Colorado, coming home in August. She was not benefitted by the change and gradually became weaker, her death being inevitable.

She was converted and joined the U. B. church when she was 12 years of age and died in the realization of Christian hope and trust. Her life was lived in this township; where she was loved and known by all and universal sorrow is felt for the bereaved ones.
