Richard Brown, 78, of Marshalltown died of complications of Alzheimer's disease Sunday at Iowa Veterans Home there. Services will be at 11 a.m. Friday at Church of the Sacred Heart in Boone, of which he was a member. Burial will be at Bass Point Cemetery there.

Mr. Brown was born in Berwick, Maine, and had lived in Boone most of his life before moving to Marshalltown a year ago.
