

Alfred Buck Rites Held At Rhodes

STATE CENTER — Alfred C. Buck, Rt. 2, died Thursday morning, Nov. 11 at the State Center Manor.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Monday at the Rhodes United Methodist Church, with the Rev. Nancy Nichols, pastor, in charge. Masonic burial followed at the Eden Cemetery.

Pallbearers were Roger Buck, Dean Buck, Norman Buck, Lawrence Buck, Jerold Buck, Michael Buck and Stephen Wolf. Ryan-Davis Funeral Home, Melbourne, was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Buck was born Nov. 17, 1895 north of Rhodes, a son of Henry G. Buck and Phoebe R. Parker Buck. He married Frances Steward on Jan. 26, 1921 at Yakima, Wash., and she survives.

Also surviving are a daughter and two sons, Mrs. Wilbur (Margaret) Wolf of Pomeroy, Wash., Donald A. Buck of Rt. 2, State Center, and Robert S. Buck of Anaheim, Calif; 18 grandchildren and nine great grandchildren, and many cousins.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister.

Mr. Buck was raised and educated in Rhodes and later

in Yakima, Wash. where he lived from 1909 until 1916 and graduated from Yakima High School.

In 1916 he returned to the Rhodes area and farmed with his father for several years, assuming management of the farms in 1921. He became semi-retired in 1950 until two years ago when he became ill.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church in Rhodes and the Farm Bureau and was a 50-year member of the Masons in Eden Lodge 466.
