Heart Attack

24 AUG 1954
Proves Fatal

To David Buck

David W. Buck, 64, Rhodes, died Tuesday at 12:30 p.m. at Evangelical Hospital. The cause of death was listed as a heart attack which he suffered in front of the courthouse in Marshalltown Aug. 13.

Mr. Buck, son of Charles and Anna Buck, was born in Welton, Jan. 14, 1890. His family moved to a farm near Rhodes when he was four years of age. On Jan. 1, 1915, he married Helen Jaroleman, and they settled on the farm and have lived there ever since. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge No. 466, E.O.S. Crystal Chapter at Rhodes, and the Congregational Church in Marshalltown.

Surviving are his widow, mother, three sons, Charles, Philip, and John, and one daughter, Mrs. Frank (Marjorie) Chrisman of Blue Springs, Mo., and 12 grandchildren.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Friday at the Rhodes Methodist Church with the Rev. Edward H. Shuey and the Rev. Ronald Dixon officiating.

Burial will be at Eden Cemetery at Rhodes.
