He was a member of the Teamsters Union and Loyal Order of Moose Lodge #313. In 1993, he received the Pilgrim Degree of Merit. Max is survived by his four sons: Floyd (Karen) Buffington of Springdale, Arkansas, David (Pat) Buffington, Kenny (Teresa) Buffington, and Dennis (Sondra) Buffington, all of Marshalltown, one brother: Floyd (Roberta) Buffington, Oskaloosa, twelve grandchildren, twenty-four great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, wife Dorothy on August 1, 2001, one great-grandchild, one half-brother and two half-sisters.
