DEATH OF PIONEER MAXWELL MAN

Rufus B. Bullard, Sr., one of the pioneer business men of the south part of the county died at his home at Maxwell at 9:00 a. m. Monday as a result of a stroke of apoplexy.

Mr. Bullard was one of the leading grain dealers in this part of the county for many years, coming to Maxwell in 1899 and continuing in business for a long term of years.

He is survived by his two sons, R. B. Bullard, Jr., of Maxwell and Gordon C. Bullard of Cambridge. The wife died about 19 years ago.
