HARRY BURGESS

Harry Burgess, 87, of Nevada, died Monday, March 12, 1984, at Iowa Veterans Home, Marshalltown, Ia., where he had been a resident for almost four years.

He was born Jan. 26, 1897, in Maxwell to Dan Edward and Pheobe Rachel Snook Burgess. He attended Maxwell schools. He lived in Collins until 1942, in Maxwell until 1950, and in Nevada since 1950.

He retired from Iowa State University with the grounds and maintenance department in 1962. He was a member of the Collins Christian Church. He was a veteran of World War I and a member of the Maxwell Veterans of Foreign Wars Post.

Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Wednesday, March 14, from Ryan Funeral Home in Nevada, with Rev. Eldon Ringle of the Collins Christian Church officiating. Interment will be at Collins Evergreen Cemetery.

Survivors include his wife Grace, a son, Gale Burgess of Grinnell, Ia.; a daughter, Irma Jane Banks of McCallsburg, Ia.; a sister, Maud Kitchen of Nevada, and three grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two children, Karen and Bruce; a brother and two sisters.

The body is at Ryan Funeral Home and visitation will begin Tuesday.
