Sept. 25, 1916, to Nov. 2, 2003

Dolar Dale Cannon, 87, formerly of Colfax and Newton, died of dementia on Sunday, Nov. 2 at the Nevada home of Barry and Michelle Stouwie, where he had lived for the past five years.
