

Mrs. Carlson ^{MAY 18} Dies Thursday ¹⁹⁷⁹

Ellen (Mrs. Albert) Carlson, 90, the Iowa Veterans Home, died Thursday afternoon at Marshalltown Area Community Hospital. Services will be Saturday at 2 p.m. at the Pursel-Davis Chapel, with the Rev. Charles Huffman officiating, and burial will be in Riverside Cemetery.

Mrs. Carlson was born Sept. 14, 1888, in Winona, Minn., the daughter of Enoch and Inger Faa Mower. She was married to Albert Carlson on Oct. 22, 1919, in Towner, N.D., and he survives.

Other survivors are her children: Allen M. Carlson, Elmhurst, Ill., and Mrs. Esther Merrill, St. Michaels, Md. There are three grandchildren, and two sisters: Mrs. Delial Wetch, Minneapolis, Minn., and Mrs. Anne Rhea, Kennewick, Wash.

Mrs. Carlson was reared and educated in Towner, N.D., and also lived in Hillsboro, N.D. (she was employed in the courthouse in Towner, and in the abstract office in Hillsboro). After she married she moved to Marshalltown and spent the remainder of her life here. She was a member of Elim Lutheran Church, the Marshalltown Woman's Club and World War I Barracks 1104 Auxiliary.
