Death of Amos Carr Wednesday at ²⁻¹ 1945 Glenwood Springs

Collins, Feb. 1—Word has been received in Collins of the death on Wednesday, January 31, of Amos "Pete" Carr, 54, which occurred at the hospital in Glenwood Springs, Colorado, where he had been taken following injuries received when kicked by a horse the last of the week.

Steve Carr left for Glenwood Springs a few days ago on receipt of word of the serious injuries suffered by his brother. He has sent back the announcement of his death and that the funeral will be held on Saturday. The time and place of the funeral was not known in Collins this morning.

Mr. Carr, born on the Carr homestead fifty-four years ago, was a son of Wyatt and Ellen Carr. He had attended the Collins schools and lived for many years in the Collins community. He had been engaged in buying, selling and training horses.

He is survived by his wife and the following brothers and sisters: Steve A. Carr and Charles Carr of Collins, John Carr of Macon, Mo., and Mrs. Olga Holm of Los Angeles, Calif.
