E. Beulah (Fertig) Carr, 94, formerly of Collins died of a respiratory infection at Story County Hospital Long Term Care, where she has been a resident for five-and-a-half years.

She was born to Edward and Alice (Brown) Fertig at Big Horn, Wyo. She married Charles B. Carr on April 10, 1925, at Des Moines. She lived as a homemaker, and as a long-time resident of Collins, she was a member of the American Legion Auxilliary and the Collins Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star.
