CARR, William C d. Feb 12, 1879

On March 5, 1850, in Colon, Mich., she was married to William C. Carr. To this union were born three children, William Wyatt of Collins; Orlando Marion, who died February 15, 1864, and Mrs Cl. a Wyanette Oxley of Maxwell. A little girl, Annie Mackey, was taken into the home at the age of six and remained there until her marriage to Simon Young, and now lives at Elm Creek, Neb.; she together with the other children, being present at the funeral.

Mr. and Mrs. Carr came from Michigan to this location in 1857 and being no railroads here, they came overland. Mrs. Carr driving one of the three teams they brought with them. Arriving here, Mr. Carr bought from the government the tract of land where Mrs. Carr has lived continuously for sixty-four years and until her death, Mr. Carr having passed away February 12, 1879.
