

Carr, Forrest E.

Following is a brief obituary of the late Forrest E. Carr, who passed away Friday evening at the home of his sister, Mrs. Victor Partridge, northwest of Collins:

Forrest Edward Carr, son of Frank and Elizabeth Carr, was born in Des Moines October 9, 1907, and departed from this life July 28, 1939. He attended the Maxwell schools and in January, 1929, he went to Pontiac, Mich., where he was employed by the General Motors Truck corporation until five weeks ago, when he returned to Iowa to make his home.

He was baptized 16 years ago and became a member of the Peoria church, which membership he continued to hold.

Funeral rites were held at the Peoria church Monday at 2 p. m., conducted by the Rev. H. S. Robinson of Des Moines, with the Rev. H. B. Fay of Farrar assisting. Mrs. Ned Pearson and daughter Phyllis gave several musical selections, among them being "In the Garden" and "Face to Face." Mrs. Larson accompanied at the piano. The pallbearers were friends and classmates of Forrest when he attended the Maxwell schools: Reese Wax of Nevada, George Olinger, Forrest Allen, Dale Johns, Richard Alvorsen and Jack Coughenour of Maxwell. Interment was in the family plot at Peoria.
