She married Tom C. Ingledue, June 22, 1929 in Dubuque, Iowa. Following Tom's death in 1935, Pearl married John "Jack" H. Carter, December 24, 1937 in Marshalltown, Iowa. Peg worked as a bookkeeper and as the office manager for radio station KFJB for 26 years, retiring July 31, 1970. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Order of the Eastern Star (Central Chapter 67), the Soroptimist Club; the Tomorrow Club and the American Legion Auxiliary. Pearl is survived by her two sons: Roger & wife Margie Ingledue, Ames, Iowa and Thomas & wife Jackie Ingledue, Kaneohe, Hawaii; six grandchildren; seven great grandchildren and two great-great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; both husbands: Tom (May 10, 1935) &, Jack (August 4, 1986); two brothers: Clifford & Harold and two sisters: Fern Freerksen & Vera Anderson.
