Former Resident William Carver 76, Laid to Rest

Funeral services for William H. Carver, 76, who died suddenly on Dec. 17, were held Saturday, Dec. 19 at the Nevada Methodist Church at 2:00 p.m. with the Rev. M. C. Shupe officiating.

Before the service and at its close Mrs. Irene Dobson played a number of sacred selections. Two songs "Just a Closer Walk With Thee" and "The Old Rugged Cross" were sung by Mrs. Glover Ambrose and Mrs. William Bolton.
