Dorothy Marie (Wilson) Casperson, 80 of Nevada died on Tuesday, April 26 at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames. Funeral services were Friday, April 29 at the First Assembly of God Church in Nevada with Rev. Thomas Poppe and Rev. Michael Casperson officiating. Burial followed in the Evergreen Memory Gardens in rural Nevada.
