

Elliott, Ida Belle Castleman (Mrs. Thomas) 1932 05 24

Mrs. Ida Elliott died at 4:30 Tuesday morning at her home in Rhodes, Ia., of cancer. She had been ailing for some time, and became seriously ill two weeks ago.

Ida Belle Castleman was born May 27, 1870, in Marshalltown. The Castleman family moved to Jasper county when she was seven years old.

She was married to Thomas W. Elliott, November 17, 1888, at Newton.

The Elliotts lived east of Collins until seven years ago when they moved to Rhodes. Mr. Elliott died August 29, 1931.
