**E. EMSLEY CHITTENDEN** d. Jan. 25, 1985

E. Emsley Chittenden, 71, of 1109 SE Michael St., Ankeny, died Friday, Jan. 25, 1985, at Mesa Arizona. Death was attributed to heart failure.

Mr. Chittenden was born at Lincoln, Neb., May 26, 1913, to Edward Joseph and Claire Iola (Albert) Chittenden. He was married to Virginia Ann Erickson in Lincoln Oct. 15, 1938.

Survivors include Mrs. Chittenden; a son, Robert, of Mitchellville; five daughters, Jane Bourgeois of Rosco, Ill., Judy Chittenden of Ankeny, Jean Martin of Santa Barbara, Calif., Joan Cummins of Bonduant and Kathleen Chittenden of Denver, Colo.; and a brother, Edward E. Chittenden of Sun City, Ariz., and seven grandchildren.

Mr. Chittenden attended Cletonia, Neb., public schools and graduated from high school in 1931. He graduated from the University of Nebraska in 1936 and was employed in the banking business in Lincoln before entering military service in 1940. He served as a major in the Army in the China-Burma-India Theater and was discharged in 1945. He operated a bank in Petersburg, Neb., ten years then moved to Collins where he was president of Exchange State Bank for 26 years. He was also chairman of the board for Farmers Saving Bank in Mitchellville the past 22 years.

He was a member of the Collins United Methodist Church, Collins American Legion Post 81, charter member of the Collins Lions Club, Collins Masonic Lodge-Scottish Rite, and Pi Sigma Kappa.

Funeral services will be at the Collins United Methodist Church Wednesday, Jan. 30, at 2 p.m. with Rev. William Ballard officiating.

Burial will be at Lincoln Memorial Cemetery, Lincoln, Neb., at 2 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 31.
