JOHN L. CHURCHILL

John Louis Churchill, son of Enoch and Susan Churchill, was born June 4, 1867, at Clinton, Ia. He passed away Oct. 26, 1944, in Chicago, Ill. at the age of 77 years, four months and 21 days.

When 11 years old he came with his parents to Ida county, Iowa, where he grew to manhood. In his early twenties he came to Lake City, Ia., where he had employment with the North Western railroad for many years.

Sept. 5, 1893, he was married to Olive Ona Betenbender of Lake

City, and to this union were born five children: Sadie Blair of Des Moines; Zola Boster of Ames; Bruce and Marion Churchill of Chicago, and Clara Kingman of Primghar. In 1929 he moved to Chicago with his wife and son Bruce.

He leaves to mourn his death besides his wife and children, five grandchildren and one great-grandchild, one sister, Mary Churchill, of Arthur, together with nieces, nephews and many friends.

Funeral services were in the Squires funeral home at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon with the Rev. Stanley A. Kruschwitz officiating. Mrs. A. M. Short was at the organ. Burial was in Lake City cemetery.
