**JESSE CLARK, 71,
DIED MONDAY**

W. J. (Jesse) Clark, 71, died Monday evening, Jan. 2, at 10:50 p.m. at his home near Maxwell, where he had been ill since May.

Funeral services will be held from the Collins Methodist church Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock, with the Rev. Robert Robinson in charge. Burial will be in the Woodland cemetery at Iowa Center. Body will lay in state at the Ryan Funeral home, Nevada, until Friday morning at 10 o'clock, when it will be taken to the church to await the funeral services.

William Jesse Clark, son of Lucinda Long and Benjamin F. Clark, was born January 15, 1884, in Dallas county, near Adel, Iowa. He departed this life January 2, 1956, at his home in Iowa Center, where he and his wife had made their home these past four years, after retiring from 40 years of farming in the Mingo and Collins communities.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his brother, all four of his sisters, as well as twin grandsons.

He is survived by the widow, Georgia Spencer Clark whom he married March 14, 1906, at Adel, Ia., and all four of their children: Mrs Iela Maxwell of Nevada, Gailard C. Clark of Collins, Mrs Elmer (Lenore) Haley of Maxwell and Glen L. Clark of Davenport. He is also survived by 15 grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren.
