Mrs. C. W. Keagle received the sad word of the death of her mother, Mrs. Mollie Morrison, 57, who passed away Monday at Riverside, Calif., after a long illness.

The body will arrive in Collins tomorrow (Friday) morning and will be taken to the Keagle home and later to Mingo, where the funeral services will be conducted at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon from the Methodist church, in charge of the pastor, the Rev. Mrs. Halverson.

Interment will be in Ashton cemetery.

Deceased was born April 14, 1881, at Mongo, La Grange county, Indiana, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Colwell. At the age of four years she came to Iowa with her mother, settling at Mingo, where her home had been since that time. Her father passed away when she was only two years of age.

In 1898 she was united in marriage to William Morrison and to this union two children were born, both of whom survive. They are Mrs. Mabel Keagle of Collins and Carl Morrison, who lives south of Collins. She is also survived by eight grandchildren and a sister, Mrs. Edd Borts of Spencer, and a host of friends.

Another sister, Mrs. McQuiston of St. Anthony, Ida., passed away two years ago.

Mrs. Morrison was engaged in the restaurant business at Mingo for a number of years, disposing of the business about a year ago when ill health made such a move necessary. Since then she made her home with her daughter, and for a time with her sister at Spencer.

She left for California on March 13 of this year, in the hope of benefit to her health.

The bereaved family has the heartfelt sympathy of the community.
