Virginia Mae Schachtlie Conrad was born June 24, 1926 in Marshalltown, the daughter of Walter and Iva Schachtlie. Virginia attended school in the Albion area and graduated from the Albion High School in 1943. She was employed by the S.S. Kresge Dime Store following her graduation. On March 7, 1948 Virginia was united in marriage to Loren Ward Conrad at the 1st Presbyterian Church in Albion. Loren and Virginia dairy farmed all of their married lives, initially in the Liscomb and Clemons area and later at her parents farm near Albion. Virginia was extremely active in Albion's 1st Presbyterian Church. She was a deacon of the church, taught Sunday school and was involved in a number of varied church activities throughout her adult life.
