Mrs. Katsaros service pending

Services here for Mrs. John Katsaros, 67, the former Mrs. John Constantine, are pending at Bruce Funeral Home.

Mrs. Katsaros, a former longtime Fort Dodge resident, died Wednesday in her apartment at Las Vegas, Nev., following a lengthy illness.
