

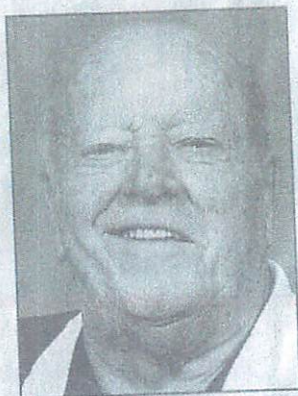
Harold Eugene 'Gene' Corbin
