Ralph Victor Leon Corbin, 88, of rural Nevada, died on Thursday, Oct. 25 at his home.

The family will receive friends from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, Nov. 3, at Chet Ryan Mortuary and Cremation Services, 708 Fifth St., Nevada. Burial of the cremains will follow in the Evergreen Memory Gardens with Pastor David R. Burling officiating.
