VINCENT E. CRABB

Military honors were accorded to Vincent E. Crabb, 49, Collins World war veteran who died from a sudden heart attack at Collins Sunday.

Born in Collins July 22, 1890, a son of Everett and Sophia Harper-Crabb, he had lived in the community all of his life.

He enlisted in the U. S. army for service in the world war July 29, 1917, serving with B Company 210 Engineers, first at Camp Dodge and later at Camp Forrest, Georgia, and was discharged from the service in 1918.

He was married to Miss Cora Kern shortly before entering the army and leaves the wife and two children, Mrs. Betty Tiffany at whose home he died, and Lucile at home.

Besides the wife and two daughters he leaves his mother, Mrs. Sophia Crabb, and a sister Mrs. John Johnson, of the Baxter neighborhood.
