## Grand jury indicts 3 in killings

A grand jury indicted an Orange City man Tuesday with first-degree murder in connection with his wife's killing, a spokeswoman for the State Attorney's Office said.

Larry Keith Roberson, 47, was formally charged with the death of his wife, Debra Roberson, whose body was found Oct. 26 in a shed on the property at 1210 Cypress Ave. where the couple lived.

Larry Roberson, caught in Levy County after 13 days on the run, confessed to the killing, investigators said. He remains without bail in the Branch Jail.

Also indicted by the grand jury Tuesday were two men charged in a drive-by shooting Nov. 5 that left one man dead and injured another. Antonio Reyes Olmos, 25, and Roberto Munoz Rivera, 23, were formally charged with first-degree murder and attempted first-degree murder. Dale Allenbaugh, 39, a disc jockey at a Daytona Beach strip club, died of gunshot wounds he suffered while riding in a sport utility vehicle on Ridgewood Avenue.
