Collette Croker, 86, of Marshalltown died of a stroke Monday at Marshalltown Medical and Surgical Center. Services will be at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Colo, of which she was a member. Burial will be at St. James Cemetery there.

Miss Croker was born in Colo and had lived there as a youth before moving to Marshalltown. She had been a registered nurse with Sisters of Mercy in Marshalltown and had served in the Army Nursing Corps during World War II. She was a member of Women of St. Henry's, Mother Teresa's Bible Sharing and Golden Classics.

She is survived by her twin sister, Callista Croker; and three brothers, James Croker of Iowa City, Richard Croker of Omaha and John Croker of Colo.
