Genevieve Curtis, 92, of Nevada, died Friday, Sept. 19, at Story County Long Term Care in Nevada, where she had been a resident since 1998.

She was born Aug. 6, 1911, in Nevada to James and Mollie (McNichols) Curtis. She was a Nevada High School graduate. She worked at R. H. Donnelley Corporation for 33 years and also worked weekends at the Ben Franklin Store in Nevada. During W.W. II, she worked at the Ankeny War Plant.
