

## Death of Mrs. Melvin Miskimmins

The following item taken from the Chugwater (Wyoming) News, will be of interest to many local people. Mr. Miskimmins formerly lived in this community, on the farm now occupied by Wm. Vasey.

Mrs. Ada Belle Miskimmins, wife of Melvin Miskimmins of near LaGrange, died at Memorial hospital in Cheyenne, Friday afternoon, March 29, after an illness of six weeks.

Funeral services were held at LaGrange Sunday afternoon, March 31, at 2 o'clock and interment made in the cemetery there, the services being conducted by Rev. W. E. Patton of Lingle.

Ada Belle Cushatt was born in Baxter, Ia. She is survived by two children, Frank Cushatt and Edna Thomas of Bear Creek, from her first marriage.

In 1889 she was married to Melvin Miskimmins at Hull, Nebr., who with six children survive her. The children are Ruth Moss of Denver, Hazel Gurney of Big Piney, Mary Mulaneaux of Sunrise, Helen Ward, Dorothy and Robert Howard of the LaGrange community. She was preceded in death by three daughters, Ethel, Edith and Myrtle. She has lived at Hull, Nebr., and near LaGrange, Wyo., for 40 years.

Besides her children she leaves 21 grandchildren and 1 great grandchild. She is also survived by her mother, two brothers and four sisters.
