## **Collins relatives get word of death of K. Dahl, Calif.**

Word was received this week of the death of Kenneth Dahl, nephew of Mrs. Ruth Huntrods of Collins.

Dahl who would have been 21 on Jan. 12, had been stationed with the army in Viet Nam one year and would have been home for his 21st birthday. He became ill New Year's Day, and was flown to Tokyo, Japan, where he died Sunday of a rare type of meningitis.

He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Duane Dahl of San Jose, Calif. Mrs. Dahl, his mother, was the former Mildred Atkinson of Collins. He is survived by his parents: two sisters; two brothers, one stationed in Germany; one niece; one nephew; two grandmothers; several aunts, uncles and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Monday at 3 p.m. in San Jose, Calif.

A scholarship in his memory has been started at the high school from which he was graduated in 1968.

His grandmother, Mabel Atkinson of Ames, and Carl Atkinson of Waterloo, flew to San Jose on Saturday to attend the services.
