June 19, 1908, to Oct. 26, 2001

Ray Jewell Danielson, 93, of Nevada, died of congestive heart failure on Friday, Oct. 26, at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames.

He was born June 19, 1908, in rural Nevada to John S. and Rachel (Rasmusson) Danielson. He was baptized and confirmed in the Bergen Lutheran Church in Roland. He was a 1927 graduate of Milford Township school and attended the University of Minnesota. He married Vera M. Eubank on June 22, 1929, in Nevada. He was a farmer and stock broker and was a member of Memorial Lutheran Church. He was also a Richland Township Trustee and a former member of Rotary.

Survivors include his daughter, Donna R. Danielson of Nevada, and a sister-in-law, Irene C. Danielson of Roland.

He is preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Vera, on Nov. 24, 1991; an infant daughter, Sandra; two brothers, Lynn and Morris; two infant brothers, LaVern and Lawrence; and two sisters, Ruby Smith and Viola Gilreath.
