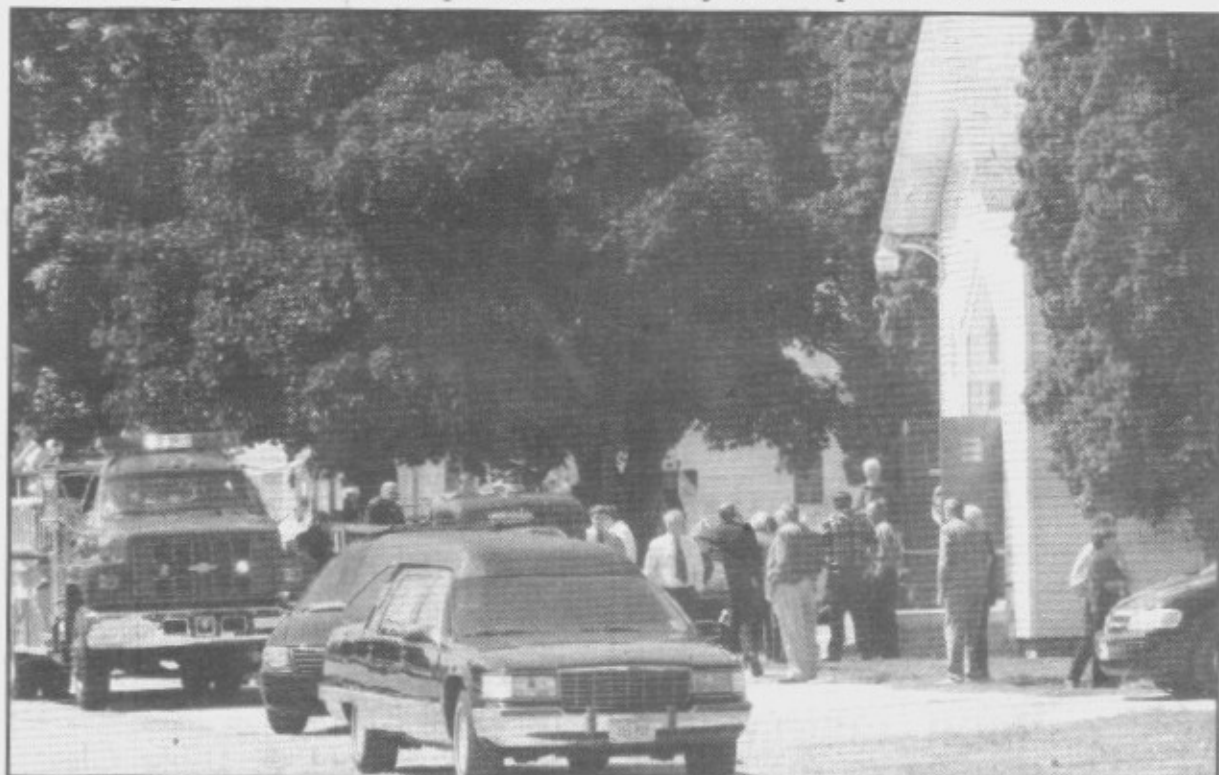
In death he has rejoined his parents, brothers George and Jake, infant sister Betty and nephew Jeff Dannen.
