

Robert Dawson Was Laid to Rest

Robert Boyce Dawson passed away at the home of Mr. and Ude Bucklin in Baxter at seven o'clock Sunday morning, after an illness of only a few days with bronchial pneumonia.

Deceased, son of Anna and Thomas Dawson, was born Aug. 11, 1864, and grew to manhood in the Collins vicinity. At the time of death he was 74 years, 6 months and 8 days of age.

He had spent all of his life in Jasper county, excepting for a short time in Missouri. For some time he had been living in the east part of Baxter.

Mr. Dawson was united in marriage to Miss Mary Carolyn Evans on Dec. 5, 1886.

He is survived by a daughter, Mrs. Rhoda Bell of Colfax; two sons, Thomas of Ira and Madison of Los Angeles, Calif., and a sister, Mrs. Arabelle Koon of Michigan. His wife preceded him in death about five years ago.

Funeral services were conducted from the Boyd funeral home at Baxter at 10:30 Wednesday morning, with the Rev. Mae Evans of Des Moines in charge, and at two o'clock Wednesday afternoon from the United Brethren church in Collins, conducted by Rev. Gray. Interment was in Collins Evergreen cemetery by the side of his wife.

Sacred selections were sung by a mixed quartet, composed of Mrs. Bradford Stevens, Mrs. A. Spivey, Emmett Weese and Milton Hale, with Mrs. R. G. Patton as accompanist.
