May 14, 1912, to Feb. 27, 2002

Ralph Thomas Dingman, 89, of Vestal, N.Y., died of congestive heart failure on Wednesday, Feb. 27, at the Good Shephard Fairview Home in Binghamton, N.Y.

He was born May 14, 1912, in Marshalltown to John and Norma (Randall) Dingman. He married Lillian G. Peterson on Sept. 1, 1935, in Nevada. Ralph was an industrial engineer with Rock Island Arsenal in Rock Island, Ill. He was a master bridge player and a scout master for the Boy Scouts.
