Charles Eugene Dodd

Charles Eugene Dodd, 76, of Chula Vista, Calif., and formerly of Nevada, died Saturday of diabetes and heart disease in San Diego. Burial will be in Fort Rosencrans Cemetery in Chula Vista.

Charles Eugene Dodd was born March 7, 1926, in Colo, the son of Roy and Mildred (Gleaves) Dodd. He graduated from Colo High School in 1943. He married Virginia Biddle July 16, 1946. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II and the Vietnam War. He operated the Sears

Charles "Chuck" Dodd, 76, who had resided in the Chula Vista, Calif., area since 1954, died Saturday, Dec. 7, in San Diego, Calif.
