L. B. Dooley, 85, of Nevada, died of cancer on Thursday, Aug. 22, at Story County Long Term Care in Nevada.

L.B. was born Oct. 8, 1916, in Hermatige, Mo., to Oliver and Ora (Cooper) Dooley. He married Helen Mae Hansen on May 6, 1939, in Nevada.
