MRS. STEPHEN H. CROSBY

Mrs. Stephen H. Crosby, 73, over 43 years a resident of Collins, and widow of Stephen H. Crosby, pioneer Collins blacksmith was found dead in her home there, Sunday evening, about 6:00, by her son Ralph, who had come to take the mother back to Newton to spend a time at his home.

The light was burning in her bedroom and examination revealed that she had been dead for 12 hours or more probably having passed away in the early morning hours.

The son had been there Saturday and made arrangements to return Sunday afternoon and take the mother to his home.

Mrs. Crosby who came to Collins with her husband in 1893, leaves two sons the husband and one son having passed away years ago.

She was born August 27, 1863, at Ottawa, Canada. She was married to Stephen H. Crosby. The husband died about 35 years ago and two years later Robert the youngest son died.

The surviving sons are Morris J. and Raymond L., both of Newton. She also leaves three granddaughters, two great-granddaughters, a sister, Mrs. Theresa Doyle of Greene, Iowa, and a brother Robert Doyle of Eagle Grove.
