Thomas Dustin, Maxwell Editor, Laid To Rest

Countless friends, over a wide area, mourn the death of Thomas D. Dustin, 66, of Maxwell, which occurred Sunday. Mr. Dustin had been in failing health for several years.

He was a resident of Maxwell for 34 years, and for 25 years was editor of the Maxwell Tribune. Deceased was a leader of Odd Fellowship in the state and was publisher of the Iowa Odd Fellow for many years. He also was a member of the Masonic lodge.

Since Mr. Dustin became ill, the business has been in charge of his son, R. L. Dustin.

The Gazette editor became acquainted with Mr. Dustin when we first came to Collins 14 years ago, and we knew him as a fine citizen, a capable editor and a grand neighbor. We sincerely regret his passing and extend heartfelt sympathy to the family.

He is survived by his wife, three sons. George of Inglewood, N. J., Richard of Maxwell and Thomas, Jr., of Milwaukee, and two grandsons.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at the Maxwell Methodist church, and interment was in Maxwell cemetery.
