Larry L. Dyer, 70, of Ames died suddenly at his home Saturday, June 25. Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday, June 30, at Bethesda Lutheran Church with the Rev. Randy Gehring officiating.

Larry L. Dyer was born March 10, 1935, in Des Moines, the son of Walter E. and Margaret (Samuelson) Dyer. He was a 1953 graduate of Ames High School and attended Electrical Technician School in Kansas City. He married Dorothy Schomaker July 26, 1959.
